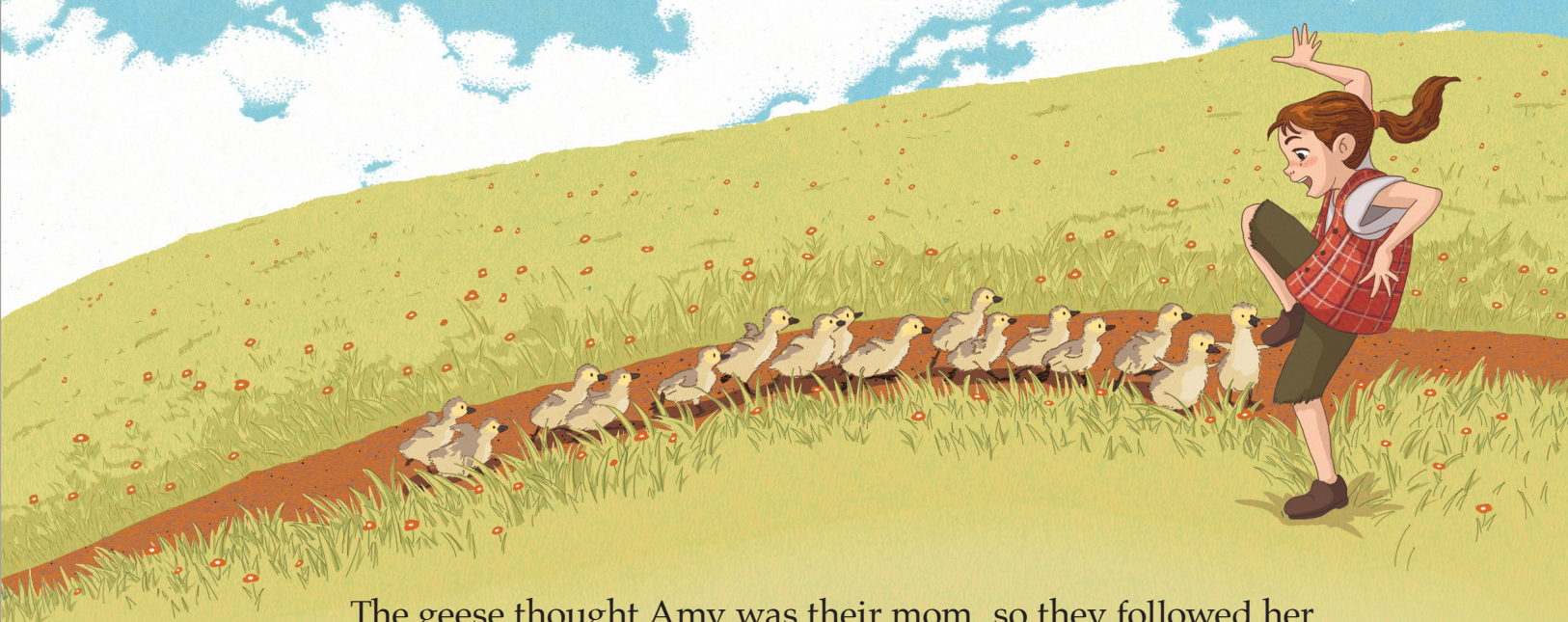
After Amy lost her mom, she moved to the countryside and lived with her dad, an inventor.

(The officer picked up a baby goose.)

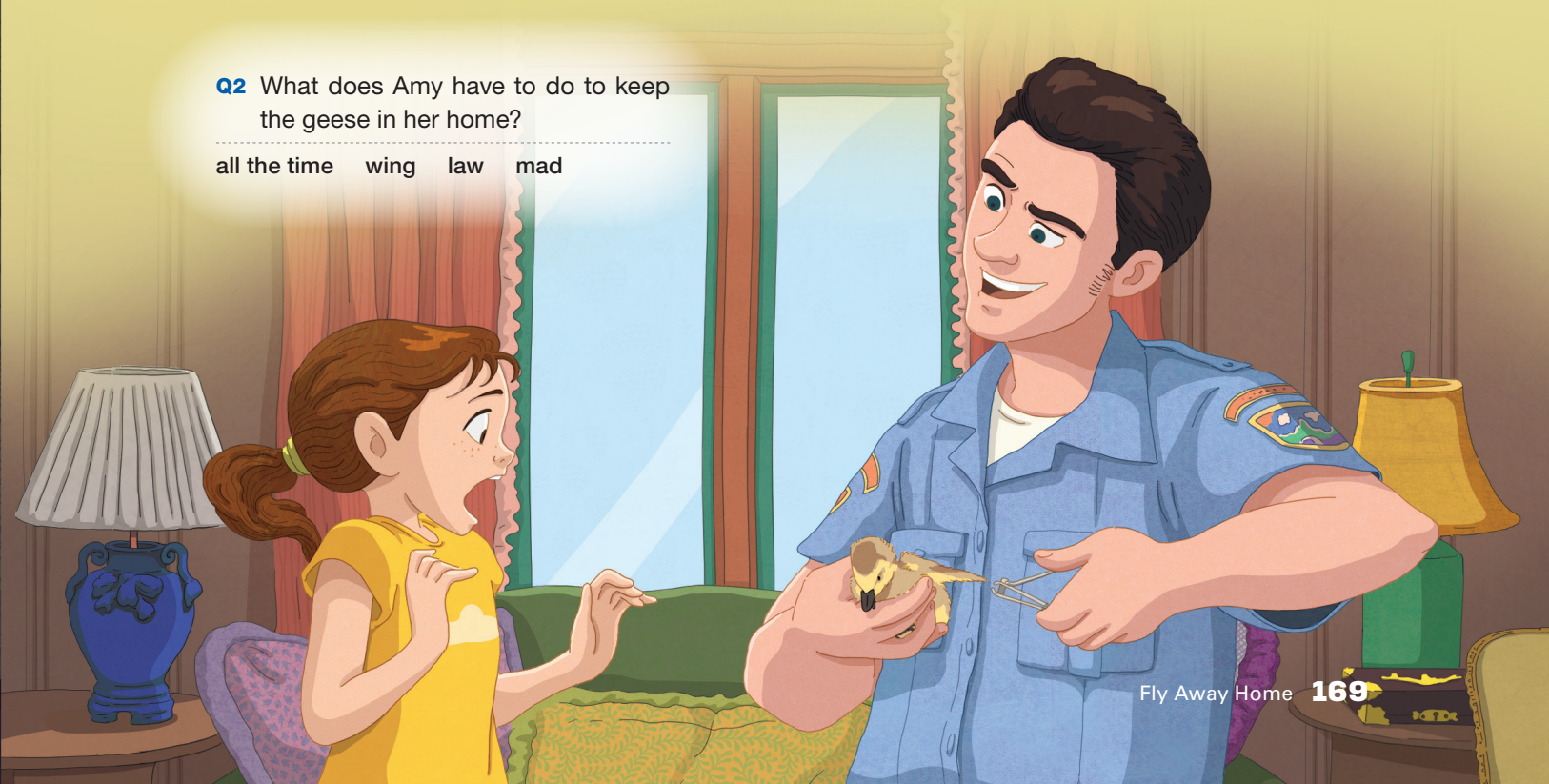
Take the wing and cut it like this ...
