The Virtual Music Factory

We tried to practice once a week through a video chat app, but we encountered several problems. First of all, we all lived in different time zones. This made it difficult to pick a convenient time for everyone to practice. Secondly, there were audio issues with the app, which caused us to be out of sync. So we put our heads together and devised a better way of playing music. We decided to assemble the songs as if we were working in a virtual music factory.

After we decided on a song, I would play it on my keyboard and send it to Singaporean Sam. He would sing along with the keyboard and send the recording to American Sam. Then American Sam would add his guitar part, and Samantha would finish the song with her drumming.

When it came to choosing songs to play, we took turns. Since each of us prefers a different genre of music and comes from a different culture, we all ended up learning a lot about different kinds of music. It was interesting and a lot of fun.

가상의 음악 공장

우리는 한 주에 한 번씩 영상 채팅 앱을 통해 연습을 하려고 노력했지만, 우리는 몇 가지 문제들에 부딪혔다. 우선, 우리는 모두 다른 시간대에 살고 있었다. 이것은 모두가 연습하기에 편한 시간을 고르는 것을 어렵게 했다. 두 번째로, 앱에 오디오 문제가 있었고, 이는 우리가 동시에 연주할 수 없게 했다. 그래서 우리는 머리를 맞대고 음악을 연주하는 더 나은 방법을 고안했다. 우리는 마치 우리가 가상의 음악 공장에서 작업하는 것처럼 노래를 조합하기로 결정했다.

'장거리 우정'

싱가포르 Sam이 회복된 후, 우리는 우리만의 곡을 쓰고 녹음하기로 결정했다. 우리는 그 노래를 '장거리 우정'이라고 불렀고, 온라인에 그것을 게시했다. 그 노래는 많은 관심을 받지는 못했지만, 우리는 우리가 함께 이룬 것에 자랑스러웠다.

More Information

버추얼 런(Virtual Run)

코로나19 이후 비대면으로 이루어지는 다양한 활동들이 등장했다. 그중 하나인 버추얼 런은 버추얼 레이스, 언택트 런, 비대면 러닝이라고도 불린다. 이것은 달리기 대회 참가자들이 오프라인에서 같은 시간에 다 함께 모여 지정된 코스를 뛰는 것이 아니라 대회 기간에 참가자 각자가 원하는 시간과 장소에서 뛰는 형태를 가리킨다.

이러한 형태의 달리기 대회는 코로나19로 인한 사회적 거리 두기를 실천하면서 등장했으며, 2020년 9월에 열린 미국 보스턴 마라톤 대회를 비롯하여 2020~2021년의 달리기 대회 대부분이 버추얼 런 방식으로 진행되었다. 버추얼 런 대회 참가자들은 대회 참가 신청 후 스마트워치나 휴대전화의 GPS 기반 러닝 앱을 활용하여 자신의 기록을 측정하고, 주최 측의 안내에 따라 홈페이지나 소셜 미디어 등에 기록을 인증한다. 참가자들은 각자 분리된 곳에서 따로 뛰지만 다른 참가자들과 함께 대회에 참가할 수 있으며, 참가 인증과 완주 인증을 받을 수 있다. 또한 전체 참가자들의 기록과 순위 등도 확인할 수 있다.
